

2010 MSP Baseball Stats Glossary

HITTERS

Top Line

G: Games

AB: At bats

R: Runs scored

H: Hits

2B: Doubles

3B: Triples

HR: Home runs

RBI: Runs batted in

TB: Total bases

K: Strikeouts

BB: Walks

IBB: Intentional walks

SH: Sacrifices

SB: Stolen bases

CS: Times caught stealing

GDP: Grounded into double play

P/PA: Pitches seen per plate appearance

HR/FB: Percentage of fly balls resulting in home runs

AVG: Batting average

OBP: On-base percentage

SLG: Slugging percentage

OPS: On-base percentage plus slugging percentage

AOPS: Adjusted OPS. OPS adjusted for home park, year, and league. Average major leaguer is 100, higher is better. A player with an AOPS of 150 has an OPS 25% greater than the league average.

BAbip: Batting average on balls in play.

Bottom Group

K%: Strikeout percentage

BB%: Walk percentage

PAT: Patience. Equal to on-base percentage minus batting average, it is how often a player gets on base via methods other than a hit.

HBP: Times hit by a pitch

AB/HR: Number of at bats per home run

ISO: Isolated slugging percentage. Equal to slugging percentage minus batting average, it is the number of "extra" bases a hitter records per at bat.

XBH%: Percentage of hits that go for extra bases.

W: Wins

L: Losses

ERA: Earned run average

WHIP: Walks plus hits per inning pitched

G: Games

GS: Games started

CG: Complete games

SV: Saves

BS: Blown saves

IP: Innings pitched

H: Hits allowed

R: Runs allowed

ER: Earned runs allowed

HR: Home runs allowed

K: Strikeouts

BB: Walks

H/9: Hits allowed per 9 innings pitched

K/9: Strikeouts per 9 innings pitched

BB/9: Walks allowed per 9 innings pitched

HR/9: Homeruns allowed per 9 innings pitched

K/BB: Number of strikeouts per walk allowed

AERA: Adjusted ERA. ERA adjusted for home park, year, and league. Average major leaguer is 100, higher is better.

XBH%: Percentage of hits allowed that go for extra bases

AVG: Batting average allowed

OBP: On-base percentage allowed

SLG: Slugging percentage allowed

OPS: On-base percentage plus slugging percentage allowed

BAbip: Batting average allowed on balls in play
